

## Information Sheet Public Safety on Axalp in Exceptional Situations

The Municipality of Brienz is committed to ensuring the safety of the permanent residents and holidaymakers on Axalp in exceptional situations.

In the event of an emergency, we urge all permanent and temporary residents on Axalp to take note of and comply with the following:

- Keep calm and stay indoors during thunderstorms and gales
- Listen to Radio Berner Oberland, frequency 94.9, cable frequency 93.3, DAB list "BEO"
- Listen to the radio in the car in the event of a power cut (hourly information updates)
- Refer to the www.rfo-brienz.ch and/or www.brienz.ch websites. Forward any information received verbally.
- Only get in touch with the points of contact in an emergency
- Lines of communication with the valley are guaranteed
- Follow the instructions of the responsible persons/authorities
- Observe and comply with road closures
- The transportation of persons and goods can only be guaranteed if the bus connection is running
